REMINDER OF HEARINGS SCHEDULED

1-22-2004	Transportation	Repeal a speed zone in Roberts County on SD Highway 15; prohibit parking along the east side of State Trunk Highway 115 in Sioux Falls north of 12 th Street for a distance of 186 feet; and amend rules for mowing of highway rights-of-way; 30 SDR 105.
1-26-2004	Education: Board of Education	Adopt and amend rules that move the implementation date of a curriculum rule back one year; amend requirements for child evaluators; allow any coursework, renewal or college transcribed, that a teacher completes by January 1, 2004, toward his or her next renewal to be honored; adopt rules for an alternative route to certification specific to the Teach for America program; and adopt rules that define certification for social workers; 30 SDR 113.
