**NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Revenue and Regulation:**  
**Banking Commission:** (January 20, 2005) has filed rules to amend the examination fee schedule for state-chartered banks; and amend the license fee rates for mortgage bankers and mortgage brokers, money lending businesses, and money order businesses. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 51A-2-13, 51A-2-36, 51A-16-9, 54-4-40, 54-4-45, 54-14-2, and 54-14-10.

A public hearing will be held at the Cultural Heritage Center located at 900 Governor's Drive, Conference Room, Pierre, South Dakota, on February 10, 2005, at 9:30 a.m.
