Department of Education: (January 23, 2004) has filed rules to implement the Hagen-Harvey memorial scholarship program. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 13-55-46.

Executive Proclamation:

Governor Rounds has issued an **Executive Proclamation** dated January 21, 2004, under the authority of Article 1, § 2 of the Constitution of the United States. The proclamation sets a Special Congressional Election for June 1, 2004, to be conducted in conjunction with the primary election. The special election is necessary to fill the vacancy caused by the resignation of William J. Janklow from the United States House of Representatives.
