### Notice of Proposed Rules

**South Dakota Board of Examiners in Optometry (Department of Health):** (January 21, 2020) intends to amend rules to clarify existing language for release of prescriptions; establish and clarify the process for license renewal and late renewal fees; update and clean up continuing education requirements and documentation; revise requirements of notification of change in professional corporation membership; and add one CPT code to clinical procedures approved for optometrists. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 36-7-13, 36-7-15, 36-7-15.1, 36-7-15.2, 36-7-15.3, 36-7-20, and 47-11B-23.

A public hearing will be held at the Tieszen Law Office, Prof. LLC, 306 East Capitol, Suite 300, Pierre, South Dakota, on March 6, 2020, at 8:00 a.m. CT. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to Executive Secretary, South Dakota Board of Examiners in Optometry, P.O. Box 513, Wall, South Dakota 57790. Materials sent by mail must reach the board by March 5, 2020, to be considered. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible location. **South Dakota State Historical Society (Department of Education):** (January 23, 2020) intends to amend rules to set standard fees for services provided by the State Historical Society. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the society, is SDCL 1-18-5, 1-18-31.2, and 1-20-21.1.
