**NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:** : (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

***Department of Game, Fish and Parks:***

(January 28, 2011) intends to amend a Uses of Parks and Public Lands rule to prohibit persons from jumping into the Big Sioux River from natural and manmade structures located within the boundaries of the Big Sioux Recreation Area (Minnehaha County); amend Public Water Zoning rules to create a "no boating zone" on a portion of the Belle Fourche River in Butte County and "no wake zones" on Twin Lakes (Minnehaha County) and on the portion of Lewis & Clark Lake (Yankton County) commonly known as the Midway Boating Beach; and amend a Refuges rule to increase the size of the Shadehill State Waterfowl Refuge in Perkins County. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 32-3A-1, 41-2-18, and 41-17-1.1.

A public hearing will be held at the Floyd Matthews Training Center, Joe Foss Building, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on March 3, 2011, at 2:00 p.m. (CST). Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to Jeffrey R. Vonk, Secretary, Foss Building, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received by and in the office of the Secretary of the Department of Game, Fish and Parks on or before 12:00 p.m. three (3) days prior to the date of the hearing to be included within the record of the public hearing and to be considered by the Commission. name and address. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Persons who have special needs for which the department can make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-3387 before the hearing.

***Department of Transportation:*** (January 28, 2011) is proposing to amend speed limits in Minnehaha County on SD Highway 11 beginning at the Minnehaha – Lincoln County line to reduce speed limits on a segment of highway near the southeast edge of the City of Sioux Falls, in Lincoln County on SD Highway 11 just south of the Minnehaha – Lincoln County line to reduce speed limits on a segment of highway near the southeast edge of the City of Sioux Falls, in Lyman County on SD Highway 47 north of its junction with SD Highway 248 to reduce the speed limit through Reliance, and in Lyman County on SD Highway 248 from its junction with SD Highway 47 south to Interstate 90 through Reliance; and adopt a Traffic Safety rule to prohibit parking along a portion of Interstate 90 Frontage Road (Sturgis Road) between Piedmont and Summerset in Meade County near Stagebarn Elementary School from 7 a.m. to 8 a.m. and 2 p.m. to 3 p.m. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 32-25-7, 32-25-7.1, and 32-30-2.4.

A public hearing will be held in the Commission Room of the Becker Hansen Building, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on February 24, 2011, at 9:05 a.m. CDST.
