On February 13, 2003, the **DEPARTMENT OF SOCIAL SERVICES** filed revisions to the Food Stamp Certification and Accountability Manual regarding income exclusions.

2-27-2003	Transportation	Amend or repeal speed zones in Minnehaha, Aurora, Corson and Dewey Counties; update definitions regarding movement of oversize or overweight vehicles; 29 SDR 115.
