**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Revenue: Commission on Gaming:** (February 15, 2013) is proposing to amend Gaming Rules to add failure to maintain minimum bankroll requirements and failure to notify the Executive Secretary of deficiency in cash, to Class A violations which allow for summary suspension of license; change the minimum wager from \$100 to \$1,000; and include summary suspension as a penalty for failure of a licensee to maintain cash or cash equivalents or to maintain minimum bankroll requirements. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the commission, is SDCL §§ 42-7B-7, 42-7B-11, and 42-7B-32.

A public hearing will be held at the City Hall, 102 Sherman Street, Deadwood, South Dakota, on March 14, 2013, at 9:00 a.m. MT. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the South Dakota Commission on Gaming, 221 West Capitol Avenue, Suite 101, c/o 1320 East Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-3100. Materials sent by mail must reach the Commission on Gaming by March 12, 2013, to be considered. However, the Commission requests that all written comments

be received by March 8, 2013, to allow for adequate consideration prior to the hearing. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Persons who have special needs for which the commission can make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-6050 or (605) 578-3074 at least 48 hours before the hearing.

2-28-2013	Department of Transportation	Amend Speed Zone rules in Spink County by repealing an existing 55 mph limited speed zone located on SD Highway 37 near the intersection of SD Highway 37 and Spink County Highway 12 and extend an existing 65 mph speed zone an additional 0.2 mile north of
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		the intersection of U.S. Highway 281 and SD Highway 20; 39 SDR 135.
3-7-2013	Game, Fish and Parks	Amend Public Water Zoning rules to repeal the existing "no boating zones" designated on Helgeson Slough in Clark County and on portions of Rock Creek Game Production Area and East Stink Lake in Marshall County; create a new "public swimming zone" fronting on a portion of shoreline of Platte Creek Recreation Area on Lake Francis Case (Charles Mix County); and repeal two existing "public swimming zones" designated on Clear Lake in Marshall County; amend a Refuges rule to remove the North Shore State Waterfowl Refuge from the list of Missouri River refuges; and amend a West River Prairie Deer Season (Special Buck Licenses) rule and an East River Deer Hunting Season (Special Buck Licenses) rule to limit an individual to possessing either an East River or West River special buck license in any given year and change the special buck license allocations; 39 SDR 135.
