REMINDER OF HEARINGS SCHEDULED

3-3-2016	Department of Game, Fish, and Parks Amend a Refuges rule to eliminate the Dry Creek State Waterfowl Refuge; adopt Application for License and General Provisions rules to enable the Game, Fish and Parks Commission to establish by resolution the allocation of limited licenses and access permits for certain hunting seasons and the paddlefish snagging and archery season. The Commission would be required, prior to adopting a license allocation resolution, to provide the public with notice which conforms with the publication requirements established in SDCL Chapter 1-26 for adoption of administrative rules; 42 SDR 117, February 16, 2016.
3-3-2016	Department of Health: Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners Adopt rules to provide a process for locum tenens certificate holders to extend the duration of the certificate; remove requirement that a physician assistant and their supervising physician visit each separate practice location; update outdated language; create continuing education requirements for licensed physical therapists; and create rules for continuing education requirements for licensed nutritionists and dietitians; 42 SDR 112, February 1, 2016.

3-14-2016	Department of Education: Board of Education Adopt Emergency Safety Intervention rules to regulate the use of emergency safety intervention (seclusion and restraint) in schools and require schools to adopt policies and procedures regarding administration, notification, training, and reporting; 42 SDR 115, February 8, 2016.
