3-1-2012	Game, Fish and Parks	Amend Public Water Zoning rules to create a "no wake zone" on Richmond Lake (Brown County), Mina Lake (Edmunds County), and Lake Mitchell (Davison County) during certain periods of high water, amend the boundaries of the existing "no wake zone" on the west end of Lake Mitchell (Davison County), create an "electric motors zone" on the waters of Rollings Game Production Area (Lincoln County), amend an existing "no motors zone" to an "electric motors zone" on the waters of Family Park (Minnehaha County), and amend an existing "public swimming zone" to a "no wake zone" on the waters of Lewis and Clark Lake (Yankton County) adjacent to Canary Beach; amend Motorboats and Watercraft rules to clarify that Coast Guard approved fire extinguishers carried on boats must be in working order, and revise the provisions for emergency signals on law enforcement and emergency rescue boats; amend West River Prairie Deer Season and Hunting License Fees rules to increase the number of both resident and nonresident "special any deer" licenses from 500 to 600 and increase the license fee

3-14-2012	Revenue: Commission on Gaming	Amend a Racing rule to clarify that wagers through multi-jurisdictional totalizator hubs are done without using simulcast site facilities or equipment; amend Gaming rules to clarify that the bonus bet is an optional bet and to clarify when the three card option should be utilized with the play Let it Ride; add an additional pay table to Ultimate Texas Hold'em; add a variation of poker known as Casino War; delete the reference to meter sign reconciliation; clarify which forms are to be used in a jackpot payout; remove a function that is not a count team function and clarify the rule; clarify which forms are to be used whenever funds are distributed to a slot machine; address storage issues for operators due to the large number of vouchers redeemed daily; and adopt the 2009 edition, including appendix chapters, of the International Building Code; 38 SDR 139.
3-26-2012	Health: Board of Dentistry	Amend rules to remove obsolete provisions and references, update references, clarify existing rules relating to requirements of dentists and dental hygienists seeking licensure, clarify existing rules relating to foreign trained dentists and dental hygienists seek licensure, amend continuing education requirements to increase the number of hours of home study courses that can be claimed in a five year continuing education cycle, clarify cardiopulmonary resuscitation courses that are accepted, extend corporation renewal deadline, increase fees across licensee and registrant categories, and implement collaborative supervision rules; 38 SDR 139.
