(February 27, 2002) The Supreme Court of the State of South Dakota will hold a public hearing to determine what is the best use of the circuit

The hearing will be held on the 22nd day of April, 2002 at the Capitol Lake Visitors Center, Pierre, South Dakota, at the hour of 2:00 p.m., (CDT). Any person interested may appear at the hearing and be heard.
