**NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

***Department of Education: Board of Education:*** (March 2, 2005) intends to amend rules that will reference the fact that the department may issue one-year certificates to teachers who have let their certificates lapse; to allow the department to grant an additional one-year extension on a one-year certificate to a teacher who has extenuating circumstances and to reference the alternative certification program; to clearly state that a teacher who lets his or her certificate lapse may be issued a one-year certificate by the department, during which time the teacher may complete the required six hours of transcribed coursework; and to clearly state the type of certificate that is to be issued to a teacher who completes an alternative route to certification. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 1-45-13, 13-1-12, 13-1-12.1, 13-3-1.4, 13-3-47, 13-5-34, 13-13-18, 13-26-2.1, 13-27-3, and 13-42-3.

A public hearing will be held in the conference room of the Pierre Public Schools Office Building, 211 South Poplar Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on March 21, 2005, at 2:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the Department of Education, South Dakota Board of Education, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-2291. Written comments must be received by March 21, 2005, to be considered. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Persons who have special needs for which the department can

make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-3426 at least 48 hours before the hearing.

## **Executive Order:**

The Governor has signed **Executive Order 2005-04** dated March 3, 2005. This order grants authority to the South Dakota Division of Wildland Fire Suppression to augment its response to any wildfires in the Black Hills during the 2005 fire season with assets from the South Dakota National Guard.
