NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Agriculture: (March 6, 2007) intends to amend the *SOUTH DAKOTA CERTIFIED*TM rules including: provide the necessary rules to establish the *SOUTH DAKOTA CERTIFIED*TM natural beef program and the *SOUTH DAKOTA CERTIFIED ENROLLED CATTLE*TM natural program; the specific natural processing requirements, limitations and definitions for beef; the specific natural feeding requirements, limitations and definitions for cattle; and the limitations for hormones and antibiotics. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 39-24-6.

A public hearing will be held in Foss Building, 1st floor, Mathew Training Center, Pierre, South Dakota, on April 2, 2007, at 1:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to South Dakota Department of Agriculture, 523 E. Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Material sent by mail must reach the department by April 12, 2007, to be considered. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
