4-1-2004	Game, Fish and Parks	Amend rules regarding the following hunting seasons: Custer State Park Deer, Custer State Park Bighorn Sheep, Special Custer State Park Antlerless Elk, Archery Antelope, Archery Deer, Archery Elk, Black Hills Elk, Prairie Elk, General Muzzleloading Deer, Black Hills Bighorn Sheep, Pheasant, Grouse, Sage Grouse, Gray Partridge, Quail, and Mourning Dove; amend dog training restrictions on Fort Pierre National Grasslands; increase the daily admission fee for the Fort Sisseton Festival; add camping permit fees at Amsden Dam, increase the cost of the daily camping fee at Fort Sisseton during the Festival, and amend and establish daily equestrian camping permit fees at Bear Butte, Lewis and Clark, Newton Hills, Oakwood Lakes, Pease Creek, Pelican Lake, and Union Grove; 30 SDR 143.
