Notice of Proposed Administrative Rules:

(The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Human Services: Division of Rehabilitation Services: (April 6, 2017) intends to adopt rules to bring the interpreter certification level required for criminal proceedings or serious medical procedures corresponding to the certification currently being granted by the Registry of Interpreters for the Deaf (RID). The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 1-36A-10.5 and 1-36A-12.

A public hearing will be held in the Large Conference Room, Hillview Plaza, 3800 E.
