**NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Social Services:** (April 7, 2015) intends to amend Economic Assistance, Medical Services, Child Support and Child Protection rules to reflect annual changes, update terminology to align with current practice, amend the mileage requirement for non-emergency medical transportation reimbursement, and clarify the exemption for family foster homes. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 25-4-45.3, 26-6-16, 28-1-50, 28-1-61, 28-6-1, 28-6-18, 28-6A-12, 28-7A-3, and 28-7A-24.

A public hearing will be held in the Kneip Conference Room 1, Kneip Office Building, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on November 24, 2014, at 3:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to Teresa Schulte, Department of Social Services, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501 or by emailing [DSSAdminRules@state.sd.us](mailto:DSSAdminRules@state.sd.us). Copies of the proposed rules are also available at: <http://rules.sd.gov>. Written comments must be received by December 4, 2014, to be considered. Individuals intending to present oral testimony at the hearing must make a written copy of their testimony available to the department at the time of the hearing. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Persons who have special needs for which the department can make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-3165 at least 48 hours before the hearing.

### DECLARATORY RULING:

The **Board of Medical and Osteopathic Examiners** has vacated its September 21, 1994, Declaratory Ruling on Universal Precautions. The South Dakota Administrative Rule, ARSD 44:20:04:01, which prompted the ruling, was repealed in December of 2004.

### NOTICE:

The Governor has announced that the name of **Shannon County** will be changed to **Oglala Lakota County** effective May 1, 2015. This name change will be implemented because the voters of Shannon County approved it and the Legislature concurred by passing HJR 1005. The Legislative Research Council will implement the name change for the county in each rule where it is necessary under its statutory authority to edit and publish the administrative rules.

### FILINGS IN THE SECRETARY OF STATE'S OFFICE:

#### Executive Order:

The Governor has signed **Executive Order 2015-06** dated April 7, 2015. This order continues "Jolene's Law Task Force" for another year. The task force will study the sexual abuse of children and make recommendations to the Legislature on policies to effectively address this issue.
