NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Transportation: (April 8, 2013) is proposing to amend Speed Zone rules in Pennington, Butte, Custer, Harding, and Meade Counties; and adopt Traffic Safety rules in Butte and Lawrence Counties. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL §§ 32-25-7, 32-25-7.1, and 32-30-2.4.

A public hearing will be held in the Commission Room of the Becker Hansen Building, 700 East Broadway Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on April 25, 2013, at 9:05 a.m. CDST. Department of Game, Fish and Parks: (April 11, 2013) intends to amend a rule regarding Camping permits and Rules to eliminate the \$2.00 differential in camping fees during cold weather periods when restroom and shower facilities are closed.
