FILINGS IN THE LEGISLATIVE

RESEARCH COUNCIL'S OFFICE: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Labor and Regulation: Division of Labor and Management: (April 18, 2016) is proposing to amend rules to revise the workers compensation fee schedule. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL § 62-7-8.

A public hearing will be held in the Conference Room 3, Kneip Building, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on May 10, 2016, at 10:00 a.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the Department of Labor and Regulation, Division of Labor and Management, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-2291.
