NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:

Department of Revenue and Regulation: South Dakota Lottery Commission: (April 25, 2003) intends to adopt rules that will provide that all video lottery machines must have a bill acceptor and may also have a coin acceptor installed; authorizes the publication of the amount of an on-line prize won; and update existing rules for the Powerball game to clarify when the Match 5 Bonus Prize becomes effective. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, are SDCL 42-7A-1 and 42-7A-21.

A public hearing will be held at 10:30 a.m. (CDT) on May 16, 2003, in the Anderson Room at the Governor's Inn, 700 West Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the South Dakota Lottery, P.O. Box 7107, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-7107. Written comments must be received on or before May 15, 2003, to be

considered. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Persons who have special needs for which the Lottery can make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-5770 at least 48 hours before the hearing.

NOTICE: The **South Dakota Lottery** is ending instant ticket game number 147 – Shamrock Smackaroos. The last day that prizes will be paid for the game is October 18, 2003.
