NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council)

Department of Game, Fish and Parks: (May 17, 2002) intends to adopt rules for the fall wild turkey hunting season to establish the number and type of licenses and tags available in certain units, repeal the unit in Jerauld County, establish, reestablish, and modify certain existing and new units, require that only archery and shot gun be used in units in Marshall and Roberts Counties, and clarify the provisions relating to the number of licenses any person may obtain; for the West River deer hunting season establish the number and types of licenses and tags available in certain units, provide for one nonresident "any deer" license and one nonresident "anterless" deer license in Unit 358 D, establish and modify boundaries and areas included in new and existing units, and modify season dates in certain counties and units; modify the required method of placement of the tag on an elk; require the use of certain wearable flotation devices by persons under age 7 and that a Type V Hybrid personal flotation device is being used. The general authority for this rule, as cited by the department, is SDCL 41-2-18, 41-6-21, 41-11-5, and 41-14-14.

A public hearing will be held at the Ramkota RiverCentre, 920 West Sioux, Pierre, South Dakota, on June 6, 2002, at 2:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to John L. Cooper,
