NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Environment and Natural Resources: Board of Minerals and

Environment: (May 19, 2003) has filed rules that will clarify the mixture rule, the addition of three wastes to the list of hazardous wastes, requirements applicable to hazardous waste facilities, and clarify requirements for the management of specific hazardous wastes. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 34A-11-8 and 34A-11-9.

A public hearing will be held at the Floyd Matthew Environmental Education and Training Center, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on July 17, 2003, at 10:15 a.m. CDT. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources, Waste Management Program, 523 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-3182. Written comments must be received prior to the hearing date. Department of Education: Board of

Education: (May 23, 2003) has filed rules that require that the Professional Teachers Practices and Standards Commission and the Professional Administrators Practices and Standards Commission hold their respective meetings annually; require teachers new to the profession to pass the state licensure exam in the pedagogy and content areas in which they will be certified,

and to allow teachers with National Board Certification to obtain five-year teaching certificates; ensure that alternative certification teacher candidates are highly qualified; and improve the retention and success of teachers in their profession. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 13-1-12.1, 13-29-2, 13-29-6, 13-42-3, 13-43-20, 13-43-25, and 13-43-55.1.

A public hearing will be held in the Northern State University Campus Centennial Room, 1200 S. Jay Street, Aberdeen, South Dakota, on June 24, 2003, at 1:35 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to the South Dakota Department of Education, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Written comments must be received by July 1, 2003, to be considered. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. 6-24-2003	Education: Board of Education	Adopt and amend rules that require that the Professional Teachers Practices and Standards Commission and the Professional Administrators Practices and Standards Commission hold their respective meetings annually; that ensure that all teachers become highly qualified and to recognize the achievements of Nationally Board Certified teachers; require alternative certification teacher candidates submit copies of their state licensure exams to the department; and establish a teacher mentorship program; 29 SDR 163.
7-17-2003	Environment and Natural Resources: Board of Minerals and Environment	Update existing hazardous waste rules by incorporating the federal rules by reference; 29 SDR 163.
