**NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES:** (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

**Department of Social Services: Child Support:** (June 11, 2008) intends to repeal obsolete rules and amend rules for a household receiving assistance from the Department, change the assignment of support rights to apply only to those months the recipient actually receives assistance; when distributing amounts of child support collected for a household currently receiving assistance, specify that the Department shall retain the amount of unpaid support obligation accrued under an assignment or the amount necessary to reimburse the Department for the cumulative amount of unreimbursed assistance paid to a family, whichever is less; if the amount collected through an Internal Revenue Services (IRS) tax refund offset is based on a joint return, allow the Department to delay distribution of amounts collected until the Department is notified that the unobligated spouse's share of the refund has been paid or up to six months from the date the offset was paid to the Department, whichever is earlier; specify that if the amount collected exceeds the amount of the unpaid support obligation, the Department shall refund the excess to the absent parent or to the parties filing a joint return within 45 days after it is collected; and eliminate the threshold amount for notifying the federal government of delinquent support obligations for purposes of denying, revoking, or limiting passports. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 25-7A-3.3 and 28-7A-3.

A public hearing will be held in the DSS Conference Room, First Floor, Kneip Office

Building, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota, on July 8, 2008, at 1:30 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to Jill Wellhouse, Administrative Rules, Department of Social Services, 700 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. Ms. Wellhouse may be contacted by telephone at (605) 773-3305. Written comments must be received by July 18, 2008, to be considered. Individuals intending to present oral testimony at the hearing must make a written copy of their testimony available to the department at the time of the hearing. The testimony must relate directly to the changes being proposed and must cite the specific rule number to which the comments are being directed. This hearing is being held in a physically accessible place. Persons who have special needs for which the department can make arrangements are asked to call (605) 773-3305 at least 48 hours before the hearing.
