The **Department of Social Services** intends to make the following changes to the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan concerning disproportionate share payments in State Fiscal Year 2016 effective July 1, 2015. The proposed State Plan Amendment (SPA) moves disproportionate share payment amounts to the Department's website. The proposed amendment revises pages 7- 8 of Attachment 4.19-A of the South Dakota Medicaid State Plan. The Department estimates there will be no federal fiscal impact associated with this SPA. The proposed amendment revises page 10 of Attachment 4.19-A of the South Dakota Medicaid State

Plan. The Department estimates there will be no federal fiscal impact associated with this SPA.
