Department of Agriculture: Value Added Finance Authority: (July 30, 2001) is proposing rules to authorize the Value Added Finance Authority to provide an additional source of financing for agricultural development. The general authority for this rule, as cited by the department, is SDCL 1-16E-24.

8-27-2001	Public Utilities Commission: One Call Notification Board	March board meeting, define duties of chair and secretary/treasurer, permit board to hire or contract duties, functions, and powers, allow excavators to assign emergency tickets; 28 SDR 15.
8-30-2001	Agriculture: Value Added Finance Authority	Authorize additional source of financing for ag development; 28 SDR 19.
