NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Public Utilities Commission: One-Call

Notification Board: (August 28, 2009) intends to amend rules to identify and classify those facilities that have the potential to cause significant environmental or safety hazards such as those transporting petroleum products and hazardous materials separate from all other underground facilities; clarify the organizational structure of the Board; require all underground facilities to be maintained in a database separate from all other facilities; allow the excavator to request notification when the facility operator identifies, prior to field dispatch, that they do not have any underground facilities in the excavation area; require the Center, at the close of the locate request, to notify the excavator making a locate request when there may be high profile facilities in the area where they have identified an intent to excavate; and provide a detailed process for identifying and excavating in proximity to a high profile underground facility and reducing the possibility of damage to this type of facility. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL 49-7A-4.

A public hearing will be held in Room 413, 4th Floor, State Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota, on September 30, 2009, at 10:00 a.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from South Dakota One-Call Notification Board, 5536 Doubletree Road, Rapid City, South Dakota 57702 or at their Web site at <http://onecall.sd.gov/Law/RulemakingDockets/2009/proposedrules.pdf>.
