NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Revenue and Regulation: South Dakota Risk Pool Board: (August 27, 2003) has filed rules that will delineate when persons are eligible for coverage, outline the appeals process, specify the process of payment for agent commissions, specify the process of payment for premiums, clarify plan provisions, and address other risk pool requirements. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 58-17-124.

A public hearing will be held in Gallery E of the Best Western Ramkota River Center, 920 W. Sioux Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on September 18, 2003, at 8:30 a.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained from and written comments sent to the Department of Revenue & Regulation, Legal Division/Rules, 445 East Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota 57501, or by emailing Beth.Christie@state.sd.us. Department of Tourism and State Development: Board of Economic Development: (August 28, 2003) has filed rules that will allow Regional Revolving Loan Funds the ability to borrow from the REDI Fund. The

general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 1-16G-5, 1-16G-8, and 1-16G-9.

On August 28, 2003, the department filed revisions for the Food Stamp Program Certification and Accountability Manual. The updates deal with corrections, TANF sanction carryover, certain reporting requirements, and amendments to income guidelines.
