NOTICES OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Public Safety: South Dakota 911 Coordination Board: (September 3, 2009) intends to adopt rules to establish operational, technical, and procedural standards for public safety answering points (PSAPs), to establish allowable costs associated with the operation of a PSAP, and to establish financial reporting criteria for PSAPs. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the department, is SDCL 34-45-18.2.

A public hearing will be held in Room 412 of the Capitol Building, 500 E. Capitol Avenue, Pierre, South Dakota, on September 30, 2009, at 1:00 p.m. Copies of the proposed rules may be obtained without charge from and written comments sent to the South Dakota Department of Public Safety, 118 West Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota 57501. 9-30-2009	Public Utilities Commission: One-Call Notification Board	Amend rules to identify and classify those facilities that have the potential to cause significant environmental or safety hazards such as those transporting petroleum products and hazardous materials separate from all other underground facilities; clarify the organizational structure of the Board; require all underground facilities to be maintained in a database separate from all other facilities; allow the excavator to request notification when the facility operator identifies, prior to field dispatch, that they do not have any underground facilities in the excavation area; require the Center, at the close of the locate request, to notify the excavator making a locate request when there may be high profile facilities in the area where they have identified an intent to excavate; and provide a detailed process for identifying and excavating in proximity to a high profile underground facility and reducing the possibility of damage to this type of facility; 36 SDR 37.
