NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Health: Board of Chiropractic Examiners: (October 27, 2014) intends to amend rules to update requirements for individuals not immediately seeking licensure after graduation; modify requirements for activating an inactive or lapsed chiropractic license; establish a rule for activating a lapsed chiropractic radiographic and chiropractic assistant certificate; modify continuing education requirements for chiropractic radiographic and chiropractic assistant certifications; and update reference material for peer review process. The general authority for these rules, as cited by the board, is SDCL §§ 36-5-4, 36-5-10, 36-5-12, 36-5-14.2, 36-5-15.2, 36-5-15.3, 36-5-19, 36-5-24, and 36-5-25.
