12-18-2015	<p>Transportation Amend Speed Limits rules on State Highway 253 through the town of Hosmer in Edmunds County beginning 9 miles North of the junction with U.S. Highway 12, the limit is 45 mph west for 0.24 mile, then 25 mph for 0.68 mile through the town of Hosmer, then 45 mph for an additional 0.2 mile west; amend a rule in Lake County on State Trunk Highway 34 in the city of Madison by reducing the maximum speed from 50 mph to 30 mph from its intersection with Washington Avenue then East for 0.17 mile, and then from 65 mph to 55 mph an additional 1.05 miles west; and a rule in Moody County on State Trunk Highway 32 (Pipestone Avenue) in the city of Flandreau, to increase from 35 mph to 45 mph step down speed zones entering and exiting Flandreau in order to provide consistent 20 mph increments on State Trunk Highway 32 through Flandreau; 42 SDR 79; November 16, 2015.</p>
