NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULES: (The date in parentheses is the date the rules were filed in the Legislative Research Council.)

Department of Game, Fish, and Parks:

(December 18, 2014) intends to amend a rule to allow dogs to be used to hunt mountain lions year round in all areas of the state located outside of the Black Hills Fire Protection District. The general authority for this rule, as cited by the department, is SDCL § 41-2-18.

A public hearing will be held at the RedRossa Conference Center, 808 W. Sioux Ave., Pierre, South Dakota, on January 15, 2015, at 2:00 p.m. (CST).
