RULES REVIEW COMMITTEE MINUTES

Two Hundred Forty-sixth Meeting

The two hundred forty-sixth meeting of the Rules Review Committee was called to order by Chair Senator Royal "Mac" McCracken at 12:00 Noon, March 15, 2004, in Room 413 of the State Capitol, Pierre, South Dakota.

A quorum was determined with the following members answering the roll call: Senators Eric Bogue, H. Paul Dennert, and Royal "Mac" McCracken; and Representatives Richard Engels, Jean Hunhoff, and Orville Smidt.

Staff members present included Doug Decker, Code Counsel, and Kris Schneider, Legislative Secretary.

All material distributed at the meeting is attached to the original minutes on file in the Legislative Research Council (LRC). For the purpose of continuity, these minutes are not necessarily in chronological order.

Approval of Minutes

Representative Engels moved, seconded by Senator Dennert, that the minutes of the January 12, 2004, meeting be approved. Motion prevailed unanimously on a voice vote.

Staff Report

Mr. Decker distributed an e-mail from Stacy Krusemark, Department of Education, regarding their intent to file the Board of Education's proposed rules that were adopted in January with the Secretary of State prior to appearing before the Interim Rules Review Committee (**Document #1**). Mr. Decker stated that this was because of the 75-day rule.

Rules Reviewed

Department of Game, Fish and Parks - Amend rules regarding the Spring wild turkey hunting season, the East and West River prairie deer season, captive game birds, and dog training.

Mr. Doug Hansen gave a brief overview of the proposed rules. He stated that because of the 75-day rule, the department would be filing the proposed rules with the Secretary of State.

Organizational Meeting

The 2004 Interim meeting schedule was set as follows: April 20, May 18, June 3, August 3, and October 15. It was further discussed that a conference call may be scheduled in late August or early September to hear rules from Game, Fish and Parks regarding the waterfowl season and the possibility of a December meeting that would correspond with the Governor's budget address.

The next Rules Review Committee meeting will be held on Tuesday, April 20, 2004.

Representative Hunhoff moved, seconded by Senator Bogue, that the meeting adjourn. Motion prevailed unanimously on a voice vote.

The meeting adjourned at 12:20 p.m.
