

Re: Follow up to Letter of Intent – Quarterly Report

As requested, for the quarter ending on March 31, 2010, for funding Tourism Challenge Grants/Co-op Marketing, Office of the Arts, and Archaeological Research Center from proceeds generated on the one-half percent increase in the gross receipts tax per SDCL 10-45D-2:

The Department of Tourism and State Development has received:

- \$2,243,706.14 from the .5% Gross Receipts

Pro rata share distribution:

- \$1,557,236.32 Tourism (.671752%)
- \$ 469,575.20 Arts (.224536%)
- \$ 216,894.62 Archaeological Research Center (.103712%)

The visitor industry began collecting the additional .5% gross receipts tax on July 1, 2009. The process begins with the visitor industry collecting the tax, transferring to the Department of Revenue and Regulation the following month, and transferring to the Department of Tourism and State Development the next month to complete the three month process.
