# 2010 Record Year for South Dakota State Park System


- 7.8 million visitors
- 263,000 overnight camping units
- \$10.6 million in park entrance and camping revenue

# 2011

## South Dakota State Parks

- Visitation through September      Down 9%
- Camping                                      Down 10%
- Revenue                                      Down 2%  
(Anticipated 9% increase with fee adjustment)
  
- \$1.2 million less revenue than anticipated
- Over \$8 million flood damage
