1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide certain information regarding postsecondary
2 technical institutes be given to parents and guardians of students in middle schools and high
3 schools.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. That § 13-28-50 be amended to read as follows:

6 13-28-50. By November first each year, each school district shall provide a list of students
7 by name in grades seven to twelve, inclusive, together with their mailing addresses, to the
8 executive director of the Board of Regents and to the secretary of the Department of Education.

9 The secretary shall distribute the information to each postsecondary technical institute located
10 in the state. The board and each postsecondary technical institute shall use the information to
11 inform the parents and guardians of any such student in any public middle school and high
12 school about the courses needed to prepare for postsecondary-level work and about the benefits
13 of such preparation. However, no school district may forward the name of any student whose
14 parent has directed that the school district not release directory information about the student.

15 The board and the secretary shall provide a format through which the information may be
16 submitted.



1 Section 2. That chapter 13-39 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
2 follows:

3 Each postsecondary technical institute shall treat all information disclosed pursuant to § 13-
4 28-50 as confidential and subject to the same restrictions that apply to personally identifiable
5 information involving any student enrolled in a postsecondary technical institute.

9 The secretary shall distribute the information to each postsecondary technical institute located
10 in the state. The board and each technical school shall use the information to inform the parents
11 and guardians of any such student in any public middle school and high school about the courses
12 needed to prepare for postsecondary-level work and about the benefits of such preparation and
13 the workforce opportunities that exist in high-demand employment fields. However, no school
14 district may forward the name of any student whose parent has directed that the school district
15 not release directory information about the student. The board and the secretary shall provide
16 a format through which the information may be submitted. The secretary shall promulgate rules



1 pursuant to chapter 1-26 to define the information to be distributed and to establish the proper
2 protocol to be used by a technical institute to handle the distributed information.

3 Section 2. That chapter 13-39 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
4 follows:

5 Each postsecondary technical institute shall treat all information distributed pursuant to
6 § 13-28-50 as confidential.
