Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Bureau of Finance and Management

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for certain higher education grant
2 programs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred
5 twenty-seven thousand six hundred thirty-three dollars (\$127,633), or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, to the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs to provide state student
7 incentive grants to qualified students in universities under the control of the Board of Regents
8 pursuant to chapter 13-55A, and one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) of federal
9 expenditure authority, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Education
10 and Cultural Affairs to provide state student incentive grants to qualified students in accredited
11 post-secondary institutions in South Dakota pursuant to chapter 13-55A.

12 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred
13 twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$127,500), or so much thereof as may be necessary,
14 to the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs to provide the tuition equalization grants

1 to qualified students in private colleges pursuant to chapter 13-55B.

2 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000)
3 of federal expenditure authority, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of
4 Education and Cultural Affairs to provide the necessary expenditure authority for the Robert C.
5 Byrd Honors Scholarship Program.

6 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) of other
7 fund authority, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Education and
8 Cultural Affairs to provide the necessary expenditure authority for the Christa McAuliffe
9 Fellowship Program.

10 Section 5. The secretary of the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall approve
11 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

12 Section 6. Any amount appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
13 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
