## HOUSE BILL NO. 1081

Introduced by: Representatives Richter, Barker, Brown (Richard), Duniphan, Fiegen, Koetzle, Peterson (Bill), and Schaunaman and Senators Everist, Aker, Munson (David), and Olson

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money for adult basic education programs.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of two hundred  
4 ninety-four thousand, six hundred thirty-three dollars (\$294,633), or so much thereof as may be  
5 necessary, to the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs to provide grants to school  
6 districts, state institutions, or community based organizations to provide funds to meet federal  
7 matching fund requirements for adult basic education programs.

8 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall approve  
9 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

10 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
11 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
