1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain speed limits on township roads.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. Unless otherwise provided pursuant to § 32-25-9.1, the speed limit on any
4 township road is the same as the speed limit on the county roads in the county in which the
5 township is located up to a maximum of fifty-five miles per hour. If the county has retained sixty-
6 five miles per hour as the speed limit for all county roads, the speed limit on township roads in
7 the county is sixty-five miles per hour unless otherwise provided pursuant to § 32-25-9.1.
8 Driving in excess of the speed limit established in this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
