1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make the speed limits on township and county roads  
2 consistent.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-25-9.1 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-25-9.1. Any board of county commissioners may determine and establish speed zones  
6 or reduced speed limits upon all or any part of the highways under its jurisdiction and upon  
7 streets and highways on the request of and after any other local authority having charge of the  
8 maintenance thereof has declared its intention to post speed zones. ~~Such speed zones~~ Unless  
9 otherwise provided pursuant to this section, the speed limit on any township road is the same as  
10 the maximum speed limit on the county roads in the county in which the township is located. Any  
11 speed zone or reduced speed limit established pursuant to this section shall be conspicuously  
12 posted at the beginning and ending of the ~~zones~~ speed zone or speed limit area by the entity  
13 having jurisdiction over the affected portion of road or highway.
