1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the transfer of certain landowner preference
2 big game licenses.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The provisions of § 41-6-71 notwithstanding, any license for the hunting of east
5 river deer, west river deer, or antelope issued to a person eighteen years of age or older as a
6 limited license pursuant to § 41-6-19.3 may be transferred, with or without payment or
7 consideration, to any resident or nonresident who is qualified to apply for hunting privileges in
8 South Dakota. However, no such license may be transferred unless the transferor owns or
9 operates at least six hundred forty acres of agricultural, grazing, or timber land.

10 Section 2. The Game, Fish, and Parks Commission shall promulgate rules pursuant to chapter
11 1-26 to establish a written form and record keeping procedures for the transfer of licenses
12 pursuant to section 1 of this Act.
