1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide for character development instruction in the
2 school curriculum.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 13-33 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 Character development instruction shall be given in all public and nonpublic elementary and
7 secondary schools in the State to impress upon the minds of the students the importance of
8 citizenship, patriotism, honesty, self discipline, self respect, sexual abstinence, respect for the
9 contributions of minority and ethnic groups to the heritage of South Dakota, regard for the
10 elderly, and respect for authority.
