1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the penalties for false reporting of a bomb and to
2 provide for civil liability.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 22-14A-22 be amended to read as follows:

5 22-14A-22. Any person who makes a false report, with intent to deceive, mislead, or
6 otherwise misinform any person, concerning the placing or planting of any bomb, dynamite,
7 explosive, or destructive device, is guilty of falsely reporting a bomb. Falsely reporting a bomb
8 is a ~~Class 1 misdemeanor, except that subsequent convictions for the offense are Class 5 felonies~~
9 Class 6 felony. Any person found guilty of falsely reporting a bomb shall pay restitution for any
10 expense incurred as a result of ~~such~~ the crime. The person is also civilly liable for any injury to
11 person or property from the false report and any costs related to responding to the false report.
12 If the person making the false report prohibited by this section is a minor, the court, in addition
13 to such other disposition as the court may impose, shall require the minor to perform at least fifty
14 hours of public service unless tried as an adult.
