HOUSE BILL NO. 1190

Introduced by: Representatives Wick, Fiegen, Monroe, Peterson (Bill), and Smidt and Senators Paisley, Daugaard, Drake, Halverson, Munson (David), and Staggers

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide a reward for any person providing information
2 or evidence leading to the arrest and conviction of any person selling or distributing any
3 tobacco products to any person under age, to provide for liquidated costs, to establish the
4 Underage Enforcement Reward Fund, and to provide the authority to promulgate rules.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. In addition to any other penalty, assessment or fine provided by law, there shall
7 be levied liquidated costs in the amount of two hundred dollars for partial reimbursement to state
8 government and its subdivisions for expenses incurred in establishing a reward of two hundred
9 dollars to any person for providing information and evidence leading to the arrest and conviction
10 of any person for the violation of subdivision 34-46-5(1) or (2).

11 Section 2. There is hereby established an Underage Enforcement Reward Fund to be
12 administered by the Unified Judicial System. After a determination by the court of the amount
13 due to pursuant to section 1 of this Act, the clerk of courts shall collect the amount due and
14 transmit the amount monthly to the state treasurer to deposit in the Underage Enforcement
15 Reward Fund.

1 Section 3. The director of court services for the Unified Judicial System may promulgate
2 rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, concerning the procedures for filing reward claims and the
3 requirements necessary to qualify for a reward pursuant to this Act.
