

AN ACT

ENTITLED, An Act to direct the Bureau of Personnel to analyze the financial feasibility of, and if found to be feasible, design a medical savings account program as an additional health coverage option for enrollees of the public employee group health insurance plan.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. The Bureau of Personnel shall conduct an analysis of the financial feasibility of offering a medical savings account program as an additional health coverage option for enrollees of the public employee group health insurance plan as provided in chapter 3-12A. If it is concluded, following the completion of the analysis, that a medical savings account program would not be more costly than the existing coverage options, the bureau shall design a medical savings account program as an additional health coverage option for enrollees of the public employee group health insurance plan and a means of implementing it. A report of the analysis, and if applicable, the medical savings account program to be offered and the plan for its implementation, shall be submitted to the Governor no later than December 1, 1997.
