1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation for certain higher education grant  
2 programs.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That House Bill 1176 as previously enacted by the Seventy-second Legislative  
5 Assembly be amended as follows:

6 On page 11, line 28 of the enacted bill, delete the first \$2,316,000 and insert \$2,010,867.  
7 Adjust all totals accordingly.

8 Section 2. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred  
9 twenty-seven thousand six hundred thirty-three dollars (\$127,633), or so much thereof as may  
10 be necessary, to the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs to provide state student  
11 incentive grants to qualified students in universities under the control of the Board of Regents  
12 pursuant to chapter 13-55A, and one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) of federal

1 expenditure authority, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Education  
2 and Cultural Affairs to provide state student incentive grants to qualified students in accredited  
3 post-secondary institutions in South Dakota pursuant to chapter 13-55A.

4 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred  
5 twenty-seven thousand five hundred dollars (\$127,500), or so much thereof as may be necessary,  
6 to the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs to provide the tuition equalization grants  
7 to qualified students in private colleges pursuant to chapter 13-55B.

8 Section 4. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred fifty  
9 thousand dollars (\$150,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of  
10 Education and Cultural Affairs to provide grants to Cheyenne River Community College in Eagle  
11 Butte, Oglala Lakota College in Kyle, Sinte Gleska University in Rosebud, Sitting Bull College  
12 in Mobridge, and Sisseton-Wahpeton Community College in Sisseton, provided the institutions  
13 maintain accreditation by the North Central Association of Colleges and Secondary Schools.

14 Section 5. The grant to each institution as provided for in section 4 of this Act shall be  
15 determined as follows:

- 16 (1) The Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall determine the total credit-  
17 hour enrollment for the 1996-97 school year at each institution;
- 18 (2) The grant to each institution shall be the appropriation in section 4 of this Act  
19 multiplied by each institution's proportionate share of the total credit hours identified  
20 in step (1).

21 Section 6. Any institution receiving a grant pursuant to section 4 of this Act shall provide the  
22 department a copy of the institution's nondiscrimination policy whereby the institution does not  
23 engage in and will discipline acts of discrimination on the basis of race, sex, religion, or natural  
24 origin in regards to its employment practices.

25 Section 7. The secretary of the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall approve

1 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.  
2 Section 8. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by  
3 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
