1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish fifty-five miles per hour as the speed limit on
2 township roads.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. Unless otherwise provided pursuant to § 32-25-9.1, no person may drive a vehicle
5 on a township road in excess of fifty-five miles per hour. Driving in excess of the speed limit
6 established in this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor.
