SENATE BILL NO. 109

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money for rural school and community
2 renewal.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the youth at risk trust fund the sum of two
5 hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Board
6 of Regents for use by the South Dakota State University college of education and counseling
7 to match funding obtained from the Kellogg Foundation and the Annenberg Rural Challenge
8 Program for Rural School and Community Renewal to provide for a statewide school reform
9 initiative.

10 Section 2. The executive director of the Board of Regents shall approve vouchers and the
11 state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

12 Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
13 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
