## SENATE BILL NO. 110

Introduced by: Senators Albers, Everist, and Ham and Representatives Broderick and Fischer-Clemens

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to place additional restrictions on a person driving with a  
2 restricted minor's driving permit.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 32-12-12 be amended to read as follows:

5 32-12-12. A restricted minor's permit may be issued, upon application and payment of the  
6 proper fee as provided for in § 32-12-16, and passage of all driver's license examination tests,  
7 to any minor between the ages of fourteen and sixteen years. A restricted minor's permit entitles  
8 the holder, while ~~having the permit in his immediate physical possession of the permit,~~ to operate  
9 a motor vehicle during the hours of 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. standard time if the motor vehicle is being  
10 operated with the permission of the minor's parents or guardian ~~and during the hours of 8 p.m.~~  
11 ~~to 6 a.m. to and from school or work by the nearest and most direct route or as part of the~~  
12 minor's employment. A restricted minor's permit entitles the holder, while in immediate physical  
13 possession of the permit, to operate a motor vehicle anytime if the motor vehicle is being  
14 operated under the direction of the minor's parent or guardian who is occupying a seat beside  
15 the driver. The restrictions as to time of operation and operation under the direction of a parent

- 1 or guardian do not apply to the holder of a valid restricted minor's permit operating a
- 2 self-propelled agricultural machine which is not subject to registration under chapter 32-5.
