1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the definition of the crime of stalking.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 Section 1. That § 22-19A-1 be amended to read as follows:

4 22-19A-1. Any person~~who~~:

5 (1) Who willfully, maliciously, and repeatedly follows or harasses another person; or ~~who~~

6 (2) Who makes a credible threat to another person with the intent to place that person in
7 reasonable fear of death or great bodily injury;

8 is guilty of the crime of stalking. Stalking is a Class 1 misdemeanor.
