1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make certain corporate livestock feeders liable for
2 property devaluations.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. The owner of any livestock animals that are bred, farrowed, fed, or raised on a
5 contractual basis on property not owned by the livestock owner is liable for any property
6 devaluation resulting from such activity if the contract specifies design, construction, or
7 operations standards or requirements that apply to the property or facilities where such activity
8 occurs. This Act does not apply to a livestock owner that is a family farm as defined in § 47-9A-
9 2, a family farm corporation as defined in § 47-9A-14, or an authorized farm corporation as
10 defined in § 47-9A-15.
