1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to classify certain persons as residents for purposes of
2 higher education tuition.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That chapter 13-53 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
5 follows:

6 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any person who graduates from a South Dakota
7 high school qualifies for resident tuition rates at the institutions controlled by the Board of
8 Regents if:

- 9 (1) The person was a South Dakota resident at the time of high school graduation and
10 lived with a parent or legal guardian who was also a South Dakota resident;
- 11 (2) A parent or legal guardian of the individual resided continuously in South Dakota
12 through the time of first attendance as provided in subdivision (3); and
- 13 (3) The person begins to attend classes no later than the fall semester of the seventh year
14 after the date of high school graduation.
