1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the number of nonresident waterfowl licenses
2 issued.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 41-6-18.1 be amended to read as follows:

5 41-6-18.1. It is a Class 2 misdemeanor for a nonresident to hunt, take or kill waterfowl
6 without a special nonresident waterfowl license and a federal migratory bird stamp or in violation
7 of the conditions of the licenses or the rules of the Game, Fish and Parks Commission.

8 A special nonresident waterfowl license, except as otherwise provided in this title, entitles
9 the licensee to hunt waterfowl for ten consecutive days. Four dollars received from the sale of
10 each nonresident waterfowl license shall be placed in the land acquisition and development fund.
11 The moneys from this fund shall be used to acquire by purchase or lease real property to be used
12 primarily for game production. For each nonresident waterfowl license sold, an amount equal to
13 the cost of a habitat stamp shall be placed into the game, fish and parks fund and shall be used
14 for the purpose of restoring the state pheasant and wildlife populations as provided in
15 § 41-2-34.1. For each nonresident waterfowl license sold, an amount equal to the cost of the

1 waterfowl restoration stamp shall be included with the moneys collected from the sale of resident
2 waterfowl restoration stamps. This license shall be in such form as the Game, Fish and Parks
3 Commission shall prescribe.

4 The provision in this section limiting the validity of a nonresident waterfowl license to ten
5 consecutive days does not apply in Union, Clay, Bon Homme, Yankton, and Charles Mix
6 counties and in such counties, the nonresident waterfowl license shall be valid during the same
7 period as is a resident waterfowl license.

8 The Game, Fish and Parks Commission ~~may~~ shall issue ~~no more than four thousand five~~
9 ~~thousand nonresident licenses in a calendar year 1997 and each year after. The Game, Fish and~~
10 Parks Commission may issue no more than six thousand nonresident licenses in calendar year
11 1998, and may issue no more than six thousand five hundred nonresident licenses in calendar
12 year 1999 and each year after.
